

## Township of Maplewood

Consent of Neighbor for Backyard Chicken Raising

Maplewood Township Ordinance 2709-13 establishes a program that will permit fifteen residents within the Township to raise up to five chickens for the purpose of egg gathering. This ordinance requires written consent of all contiguous property owners.

This ordinance requires that persons participating in the program will complete an application showing dimensions of the coop and run and showing distances from homes and neighboring properties. No coop or run is to be closer than ten (10) feet from a property line or thirty (30) feet from a neighboring house. If the distances are less than these, then additional written consent (part 2. below) is required. All portions of the coop and run are to be kept in a clean sanitary condition. Any evidence of rodent infestation will result in revocation of the permit. Failure to abide by the provisions of the ordinance or failure to keep the coop and run in a sanitary condition will result in revocation of the permit. No roosters are allowed.
